The policy on speed and road traffic rules

The policy on driving hours and working

The driver agrees to complete each day's timesheet and signed back to the employer at the end of the work period and to respect the rules on driving hours and working conditions.

The policy on departure inspection

The driver agrees to always make a trip inspection and identify any defects that may occur along the way. The driver is obliged to keep the signed form to the vehicle for the day and give it to the employer upon her return to home port in accordance with the regulations.

The policy on accident

The driver must never leave the scene of an accident or incident without calling a police officer to make an accident report. In an emergency, it must also notify the employer.

The policy on the use of drugs and alcohol

For driver safety, and for that of motorists, the company specifically prohibits the use of drugs and alcohol during working hours or driving under the effects of drugs and alcohol. Any violation will be subject to immediate dismissal without further disciplinary notice. In addition, a screening test may be required in case of reasonable doubt or accident.
